



BOOK SCHEME

Sue Larking is the lead in the scheme that will be run by the WI. The system for replacing books in the bookcase in the Waiting Room shall be as follows:

- There will be mainly paperbacks and some children's books.
- They will be collected from people who offer books and store them. The WI will be restricting numbers that they collect. ie no more than 10 books.
- Natasha will let the WI know if some are left without her seeing them and they will be collected if there are too many for the shelf.
- People may leave a book as they pick one up, swapping one for the other, which will be acceptable.
- Sue and/or a member of the team will visit on a Monday and then twice more during the week to monitor the removal rate and restock.
- The WI team have limited storage so would ask that people are discouraged from turning out their bookshelves.

Once this scheme has run for a few weeks, Sue's name and number can be given out to those wanting to donate, paperbacks and children's books. The WI may advertise for books once the stock is low, but this is unlikely to be before 2025.
